KUTRRH is a premier referral hospital with core mandate being to provide complex clinical care to patients referred from lower level institutions. The hospital has sufficient resources to receive emergency and non-emergency patient transfers and referrals from all places across the country, region & global.

The Hospital is located along Northern Bypass Rd. near Kahawa West, Nairobi.

Even though KUTRRH was categorized as an isolation and treatment facility for the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic on 24th March, 2020, The Hospital is continuing with the other medical services. All relevant health protocols and measures have been adopted to attend to the non-COVID patients including completely separate clinics and observation areas.

The following departments and clinics are fully operational and providing services to patients.

a) Cancer Centre:

In this Centre the hospital is running the Cancer Clinic, and providing critical services including Medical Oncology, Radio-oncology services and Radiation therapy.

b) Renal services:

Our patients are able to access dialysis services from our twenty (20) bed dialysis unit.
