The Egyptian Agency of Partnership for Development (EAPD) in collaboration with the Centre for Training Research Consultation (CTRC), Faculty of Nursing, Cairo University will organize a Training Course on **“Quality Nursing Care to prevent Maternal and Fetal Death”** from 3rd October 2021 to 14th October 2021. The Hospital would therefore like to competitively nominate two (2) nurses (one principal and one substitute). Potential nominees should meet the following criteria:

- i. Should be nurses working in the field of Women’s Healthcare centers, antenatal care and labour units not exceeding 50 years of age and who haven’t previously participated in the titled training course
- ii. Holders of a Degree or Diploma in Nursing with an NCK-licensed specialization in Pediatric Nursing, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU), Neonatal Nursing, Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) or Midwifery
- iii. Have excellent command of English Language
- iv. Must have served in employment of KUTRRH on full-time basis for a minimum period of one (1) year
- v. Must have demonstrable a strong work ethic and a positive attitude towards work
- vi. Must have a clean disciplinary record
- vii. Staff who have previously benefitted from local or international training opportunities in the last one year will NOT be eligible
- viii. Must be holders of a passport with a validity of at least one year before 15th September 2021
